REHOBOTH EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMME (REAP)

The objective of **REAP** is to expand the educational provision of Rehoboth Children's Homes Trust into the local community. This would be done by assisting local families to send their children, who would benefit from further education, to college.



Students would remain in their own homes and study at a local further education college. Rehoboth would be responsible for their tuition fees and uniform. Assistance towards other expenses such as books, stationary, field trips and transportation, would be dependent on parental income.

The student's attendance and progress will be monitored by Rehoboth Children's Home's social worker who will communicate regularly with the college. Report cards of the student will be submitted to Rehoboth at the end of every semester. Once a month there will be a meeting at Rehoboth for **REAP** students.



Families of **REAP** students as well as making a financial contribution where possible, will be expected to support their children and enter into a partnership with Rehoboth. This will include voluntary help at the Home and attending meetings concerning their child's educational welfare. Rehoboth will work



together with the family to show the importance of a stable, loving and Christian environment.

ROLE OF A SPONSOR

Financial contribution: The cost of support for a sponsored student's education varies depending on the stage of education from approximately £10/month at elementary to £45/month at college. We ask that you make a contribution as you feel able. Sponsors can be individuals, groups or churches. The length of sponsorship would be dependent on the course chosen by the student. Vocational courses are normally one to two years, while degree courses can be between two and five years.

Prayer: Sponsorship is a personal link between you and your student. It is not only a financial undertaking but also a prayer link. Please pray regularly for your sponsored student and their family.

Correspondence: Part of the personal link is to keep in touch with your sponsored student by writing letters and cards. Please write about your home, family, work, holidays, recreation and church. Please do not write about politics. Please send photographs of yourself and your family. If you have children encourage them to write or draw a picture to send. If the letter is from a group let all the children sign the letter. Please do not include your address when writing to your student and please do not send presents for mailing or enclose bulky items in letters.
