# Information for Sponsors

Isaac and his servants dug a well (*Genesis 26:22*) and called it '**Rehoboth**', meaning 'room or enlargement'. Isaac said "For now the Lord has made room for us and we shall be fruitful in the land." We too believe that God has made a place for the children at Rehoboth, where they will prosper both physically and spiritually in the land.



## OBJECTIVES

"To promote the physical, mental and spiritual development of the poor, deprived, abandoned and orphaned children by providing them shelter, food, education and love. To encourage them to see the importance of a family by providing them with a Christian atmosphere and to restore them to their own homes. To help find employment for them wherever possible and to prepare them to be good God-fearing citizens." We do not feel that sponsorship is just giving money but supporting the child in their growth to Christian maturity. This can be done through prayer and regular contact with the child.



## ROLE OF A SPONSOR

**Financial contribution:** We ask sponsors to give what they feel led to contribute. You will appreciate that the older the children become, the more it costs to provide for their needs, especially as they move into college education. The donation is used to cover the costs of feeding, clothing and educating your child, which are between £20 to £50 a month. Money is also received from a number of churches and individuals who give regularly to Rehoboth, and from one-off donations and this helps meet the staff and facility costs. It is also possible to share the sponsorship of a child with someone else.



**Prayer:** Sponsorship is a personal link between you and your child. It is not only a financial undertaking but also a prayer link. Please pray regularly for your sponsored child.

**Correspondence:** Part of the personal link is to keep in touch with your sponsored child by writing letters and cards. Please write about your home, family, work, holidays, recreation and church. Please do not write about politics. Please send photographs of yourself and your family. If you have children encourage them to write or draw a picture to send. If the letter is from a group let all the children sign the letter. Please do not include your address when writing to your child.



**Birthdays & Christmas:** Birthdays and Christmas are special times for your sponsored child so we ask that you send a card to celebrate these occasions. If you would like to send a gift of money on each occasion we suggest a maximum of £10. This will be given to your child so they can choose something to buy. Any extra money will be put towards joint monthly and Christmas celebrations. Please do not send presents for mailing or enclose any bulky items in letters.
